- **LABOR DAY** annually held on the first Monday of September. It was initially organized to celebrate various labor associations' strengths and contributions of the US economy. It is mostly a day of rest in modern times. Many people mark Labor Day as the end of the summer season and the last chance to make trips or hold outdoor events. Have a great Labor Day Week!
- **PATRIOTS' DAY** is an annual observance of the 9/11 remembering those who were injured and died during the terrorist attacks in the USA on Sep 11, 2001. Many Americans refer it now as Patriots' Day. WE ARE OPEN: REGULAR HOURS.

- **COLUMBUS DAY** which is every 2nd Mon of Oct remembering Christopher Columbus' arrival to the Americans on Oct 12, 1492. WE ARE OPEN: REGULAR SCHOOL HOURS
- **WINTER SOLO APPLICATION DEADLINE: Nov 14, 2019.** Competition in recital format where performers perform ANY original repertoire that is NOT FROM THE Baroque Period. Festival date: Jan 18, 2020, at Cerritos College (BC-51).
- **THANKSGIVING DAY,** an annual holiday in the US since 1963 American Indian Heritage Day observed at this time of the year. The first Thanksgiving Day held in the city of El Paso, Texas, 1598. Another new event took place in 1619 in the Virginia Colony. Many people trace the origins of the modern Thanksgiving Day to the harvest celebration that the Pilgrims held in Plymouth, Mass in 1621. However, the first real Thanksgiving was in 1623 when they gave thanks for the rain that ended a drought. The SCHOOL CLOSES ON THANKSGIVING DAY: Happy Thanksgiving!
